

Dylan Taylor, Chairman & Founder



- Dylan Taylor is a global business leader and philanthropist. He is an active pioneer in the space exploration industry as a CEO, investor, thought leader and futurist. Currently, Dylan serves as Chairman & CEO of Voyager Space Holdings, a multi-national space holding firm that acquires and integrates leading space exploration enterprises globally.
- Dylan has been cited by Harvard University, SpaceNews, the BBC, Pitchbook, CNBC and others as having played a seminal role in the growth of the private space industry. As an early-stage investor in more than 50 emerging ventures, including Accion, Kepler, York, Astrobotic, Made in Space, Relativity, and Planet, Dylan is widely considered the most active private space investor in the world.
- Dylan's technical background, global business experience and unbridled passion for space make him a unique figure within his industry. He regularly speaks

- and writes about the future of the space economy and is sought after by the media for his expertise in the financial aspects of space investing as well as industry dynamics. As a writer and columnist, he has written several widely read pieces on the future of the space industry for SpaceNews, ROOM and Apogeo Spatial. As a speaker, Dylan has keynoted many of the major space conferences and has appeared regularly on Bloomberg, Fox Business and CNBC.

- Founded by Dylan Taylor in 2017, Space For Humanity is a US located 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization based in Denver, CO.
- Space For Humanity's mission is to expand access to space for all of humanity.
- Space For Humanity's programs include the planet's first Citizen Astronaut Sponsorship Program and Overview Leadership Program; research reports and resources; community collaborations and partnerships; a podcast titled "Overview Sessions" and launch parties and events featuring guest panelists and expert conversations.
- Space For Humanity's Citizen Astronaut Program includes a sponsored ticket, overview leadership program training and access to an overview cohort network.
- Space For Humanity has 6 full time employees and contractors as well as a team of volunteers that donate their time to support the organization's audacious mission.
- Space For Humanity has a robust board of advisors including four former astronauts, leaders at NASA, scientists, engineers and leaders in the commercial space sector.
- Space For Humanity is ranked in the top 100 non-profits globally, in terms of online engagement.





FAQs

How does the program work?

- Space for Humanity is sponsoring a group of exceptional leaders to join the world's first Citizen Astronaut Program. Applicants will be selected by a diverse committee to enter into our Leadership Training & Cohort program. Upon return, we support you to lead from an Overview Perspective here on Earth.
- We are looking for change-makers from all walks of life: those who can share an Overview-informed worldview far and wide, creating a ripple effect. We're after a global paradigm shift, and seeking partners who will make it happen.

How will you be selecting which leaders are lucky enough to be sent to space through S4H?

- We begin with an application process followed by a thorough vetting and interview process carried out by a diverse committee. The application process looks for individuals who exhibit a strong and clear commitment to the mission of Space for Humanity, demonstrated leadership skills, and have unique and altruistic personal stories, passions, and platforms.
- The Citizen Astronaut Program selection process is orchestrated by the Space for Humanity team, advisors, researchers, and our Overview Leadership Training partners. It is imperative that a global team from diverse backgrounds evaluate the applications to ensure inclusivity.

What are the application requirements?

- 18+ years old.
- · Proficient in English
- Passion for humanity and a desire to positively impact the world
- Currently serving in a community leadership role
- Clear understanding and commitment to Space for Humanity mission
- Demonstrated leadership and effective communication skills
- Effective and compelling communicator
- Self motivated problem solver
- Authentic, open and empathetic

Why do I have to speak English to apply?

 English is the official language of aviation, so for now, all Space for Humanity applicants must speak English so that they can communicate with ground crew.

How can I increase my chances of being selected?

• Your application should inspire and show us your passion! Be original, creative, and honest as to why you should be selected for this incredible opportunity. Take the application seriously, and let your personality shine! Before you apply, think about how the mission might change you, and how you intend to bring these insights and experiences back to your community. Tell us your story: How will you create a lasting positive impact on society if we select you to go to space?

How much do flights cost?

 Depending on the flight provider, there are a range of prices. Public prices currently range from \$50K to \$450K.

Who are you flying with? When?

- As an organization we are vehicle agnostic. With the speed at which advances in commercial space and human spaceflight are moving we will continue to expand our launch providers in lockstep to support our goal of truly democratizing space.
- At this point, we intend to fly with both Blue Origin, Virgin Galactic, World View, and Space Perspective.

You're not sending people to space for another few years, what are you doing in the meantime?

 Until we are at the point where sending citizen astronauts to space is a reality, we are focused on continuing our work to expand access to space, train leaders of tomorrow and contribute to a culture of interconnectedness through a variety of programs.

Where do your funds come from?

- As a not-for-profit organization, our funds come from generous donors, corporate sponsors, and grants.
- Every level of donation is used to help us fund our Citizen Astronaut Program and support our community of dedicated teammates, volunteers, and interns that show up every day to help ensure an inclusive future in space for all of humanity.

Where do your funds come from?

- As a not-for-profit organization, our funds come from generous donors, corporate sponsors, and grants.

How is the flight financed?

 The flights are financed by a combination of donations from generous future/past commercial astronauts, as well as S4H general funding.

Who is on the selection committee, and how are the Citizen Astronauts selected?

S4H's Citizen Astronaut Program (CAP) selection process is a comprehensive review of an applicant's leadership, impact, and community development experience and skills. Applicants must demonstrate character, competence, confidence, caring, connection, and contribution as well as pass a series of background checks and health screenings. S4H's diverse selection committee is comprised of members from the inclusion council, research team, and board members. The committee uses rubrics to score applicants within each of the previously listed categories. Finalists then complete a series of interviews with the selection committee and ultimately our Citizen Astronauts(s) are selected.

When are applications open again?

• We will open our next round of applications in 2023.

Is this a contest?

 No. Space for Humanity's cohort program is comparable to a fellowship, where individuals are selected based on commitment to the mission and potential for impact. After their flight, they will commit themselves to a year or more of impact work in their communities.

What exactly is an ambassador?

• Our ambassadors are people who represent the Overview Effect in their lives, in their own unique ways.
